

## **DOG TAGS**


DOG TAGS are necklaces worn by soldiers for identification.

Military Dog Tags are now often referred to as I.D. Tags (Identification Tags).

They were originally called *Dog* Tags because they looked similar to tags worn by pet dogs.

These tags are made up of two identical pieces. In the event the wearer is killed and conditions do not permit the casualty to be recovered, one tag remains with the body while the other tag is collected.
